The Chairman, Department of Computer Science and Engineering, welcomed the Board of Studies members. The chairman presented the vision and mission of the department, PEOs, POs, curriculum, and syllabi for UG Sem III and Sem IV under Regulation 2021.

Following points were discussed at the Board of Studies.

RESOLUTIONS:

1. Action taken on the minutes of the 6th BOS meeting:

The minutes of the 6th BoS meeting and the action taken thereon are approved.

2. The Curriculum and syllabi for III and IV Semesters of UG Programme under Regulation 2021

Resolved to approve that the following recommendation of the Choice based Credit System based curriculum and syllabi for the B.E. Computer Science and Engineering programme under Regulations 2021 may be passed with the following suggestions to the standing committee of the Academic Council:

- Ms.Hema Gopal proposed incorporating industry input into the laboratory's list of experiments.

- Dr. S. Prabhu suggested that the syllabus content in the third unit of the Data Visualization course be reduced because the content in unit three appears to be too large.
- Mr. Palanisamy suggested that unit three of the Design and Analysis of Algorithms course be expanded to include random quick sort.
- Mr. Palanisamy recommended to the following topics to the Software Engineering course:
 - i. Scrum to be added in Unit I
 - ii. Data Dictionary may be implemented with Oracle Database
 - iii. Cyclomatic complexity may be added in unit V
- Mr. Sanjay Mishra suggested the following points:
 - i. Blend all the learning through integrated use case(s).
 - ii. Provide more context to the teaching with industry use cases
 - iii. Include DevOps and security in the curriculum.
- Mr.P.Aswin Ram recommended that the project-based approach may be adopted.

3. Any other matter

It is resolved that the following recommendations may be passed to the standing committee of the Academic Council.

- Members of the board had appreciated the efforts taken by the department in framing the curriculum and syllabus by referring to various universities and incorporating industry inputs.
- The Board of studies members appreciated that the curriculum and syllabi meet the industry expectations.
