1	Teaching- Learning Process	 The members congratulated and appreciated all the faculty members and the supporting staff for the efforts taken to achieve the Autonomous status of the institution. The institute has made remarkable progress at streamlining the Teaching-Learning Process. The academic calendar has been prepared at the beginning of the semester and the activities are conducted as per the schedule. Faculty members are using effectively the ICT tools for their Teaching-Learning Process. Continuous Assessment Test follows the academic schedule and the performance of the students has been improved. As the institution becomes Autonomous, the blended teaching has been introduced which improves the students thinking ability. Industry oriented courses and one credit courses can be introduced with the recent advancements in the respective fields. More number of experienced faculty members can be inducted to further strengthen the academic processes.

Center for Product Development has initiated the innovative product development and it can further enhanced for societal use. Consultancy and Patents publications to be improved by all the departments.
