


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Gestures

- play a significant role in communication
- Timing of gesture is important
- play with a ring, touching a leg when looking at a different direction, clapping hands very lightly distract the speaker and affect communication in bad
- gestures are made to communicate short messages like 'yes', 'no', 'come here', 'go there', 'be silent'
- thumbs up, thumbs down, come here, okay, peace, crossed, one finger up, stop, time out, clat, quiet, point, hand shake
- thanks up, thanks down, dragging of shoulder are important gestures!
